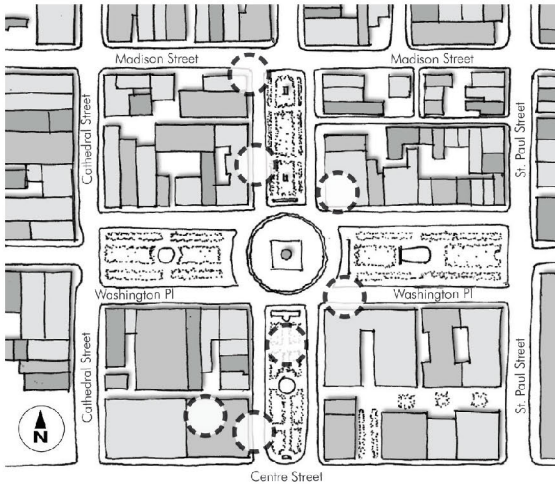


Mount Vernon Place SCAVENGER HUNT

Can you find these **architectural elements?**



1. Sea Urchin

Ornamental carvings or sculptures near a water feature in Mt. Vernon.



2. Guardian Lion

An ornament hinged to a door, historically used by visitors to attract attention and gain entry into a building.



3. Turret

A small tower that projects vertically from the wall of a building.



4. Canopy

An overhead structure that provides shade or shelter from sun, snow, and rain.



5. Colonnade

A row or sequence of columns supporting a roof.



6. Rose Window

A circular window with mullions or tracery radiating in a form suggestive of a rose.



7. Keystone

A central stone at the summit of an arch, locking the whole together.
